

**SANDIA PEAK LIFT EVACUATION EVALUATION RECORD**

- Put on the harness.
- Introduce yourself and briefly tell evacuees what you'll be doing. Advise them to drop their ski poles as necessary and to secure any loose clothing or hair, which might get caught during the evacuation.
- Attach free end of the evacuation rope to the throw line and pull evacuation rope over the cable. Keep rope out of passenger's reach until ready to belay.
- Position line saver on cable.
- Instruct evacuee on use of evacuation seat and demonstrate:
  - a. Caution evacuee not to touch the rope until instructed.
  - b. Chest strap over both shoulders (unless customer is too large, then only one shoulder) and slip ring.
  - c. Seat position under buttocks.
  - d. Sliding out of chair and turning around.
- Bring line saver to the evacuation position against the grip.
- Bring evacuation seat up to a position just below the lift chair, reminding evacuee not to touch the rope. Wrap the evacuation rope around the J-Seat (as required)
  - a. No wraps for a child or small person.
  - b. One wrap for an average size adult.
  - c. Two wraps for a large person.
  - d. Three wraps for a huge person.
- Run the rope through the rescue "8", hook it into the locking carabiner on the harness and lock the carabiner by screwing it down. Check for loose clothing that might get in the way. **(CPI - Instructor checks out this step before proceeding).**
- Pull evacuation chair the rest of the way up to the evacuee. From this point on the belay hand never leaves the belay rope until the passenger is on the ground **(CPI)**
- Instruct the evacuee to:
  - a. Put on chest strap and tighten the slip ring.
  - b. Mount the seat.
- Evacuator positions his or herself slightly downhill of chair.
- Instruct evacuee to slide seat out of the chair and then turn around to face chair.
- Belay passenger to ground.
- Direct second to assist evacuee by aligning skis across hill, etc. (as required)
- Record name, address and phone number on the 2 part drink coupon, give one half to the evacuee, and instruct them to go to the information center.
- Prepare for next evacuation &/or flip evacuation rope over chair and slide to next chair.
